



“AMONG REED & TRADITIONS” BOAT TOUR

(DURATION: 8HRS APPROX.)

Our “Local Friend” will pick you up from your hotel in the car and you’ll be taken to the pier to take a motor boat in order to sail for the islands, man-made structures done entirely of reeds.

First, you’ll go to Uros Islands, where you’ll enjoy a warm greeting by the friendly locals, who show you around their rustic homes while your “Local Friend” explains the fascinating history behind these reed islands. You’ll walk around and interact with the natives, also have the chance to ride a reed boat with them through the gentle waters of the world’s highest lake (extra charge).



The trip will continue, as you go to the Taquile Island. After disembarking at this place, that has avoided the metropolitan development of the modern world, you’ll have to walk up along a narrow path, enjoying the views of the Lake Titicaca and the typical houses inhabited by quechua natives.



You’ll have lunch here (quinoa soup, trout and a beverage) and after that you’ll explore the island learning about the reversals in stereotypical gender roles that happen here and how they create their beautiful traditional woven clothes, colorful textiles and artisan treasures by using ancient methods.

After your culturally enriching exploration you’ll walk down to the pier to take the motor boat in order to return to the mainland and go back to your hotel in Puno. That will be the end of the tour.

WHAT’S INCLUDED: Private local guide, private vehicle, private local driver, entry tickets and lunch at Taquile Island.

WHAT’S NOT INCLUDED: Extra food, drinks, gratuities and personal expenses.
