

CHINCHERO - MARAS - MORAY - OLLANTAYTAMBO

(DURATION: 8 HRS APPROX.)



Our "Local Friend", and the vehicle, will pick you up from your Hotel in the morning. You'll take the route to Urubamba going through picturesque towns like Poroy and Cachimayo, making stops at the points of interest like lookouts, etc.

You'll visit the town of Chinchero, going to the textile center (where you'll be explained and see how the traditional textiles are made following ancient methods).

After 45kms of travelling you'll visit the archaeological site of Moray, circular terraces considered centers of agricultural experimentation o agricultural labs. For



visiting, you'll descend only until the middle of the terraces (the Ministry of Culture closed and prohibited the entrance to the lower part of the terraced for protection).



Then you'll go to the Maras village, you'll cross the town walking, admiring the beautiful colonial facades that decorate each house (considered Cultural Patrimony of Humanity by UNESCO) where you'll not only appreciate and understand the iconography of each one, made from XVI until XX century, but also the way of living and typical dress of the villagers.

Later you'll continue to the Maras Salt Mines, a place where you can see how salt is extracted in a manual and artisanal way. You'll see how the whole process is.

After this you'll be headed towards Ollantaytambo, where we'll visit the Inca temple and archeological site.

Finally, you'll be taken the Ollantaytambo Train station and that will be the end of our services.

WHAT'S INCLUDED: Private local guide, private vehicle and private local driver
WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED: Entry tickets, food, drinks, gratuities and personal expenses.

STARTING TIME: Choose any time between 8:00 AM - 9:00 AM. For starting times out of this schedule, please ask.
