



# “EVENING LIGHTS” WALKING & CAR TOUR (DURATION: 5HRS APPROX.)

Your adventure begins when your friendly local guide and private driver whisk you away from your hotel to Barranco, Lima's artistic heart. This bohemian district, with its colorful streets and unique character, invites you to explore its iconic Bridge of Sighs, the serene mirador, the historical Ermita chapel, and the lively main park. Here, you'll also be treated to breathtaking views of the Pacific Ocean.



The tour continues in Lima's historic center, where grandeur and nostalgia converge. Starting at Plaza San Martín, you'll take in the elegant blend of art deco and nouveau architecture while strolling along Jirón de la Unión, a lively pedestrian street that leads to the

iconic Main Plaza. This central square is a treasure trove of landmarks, including the Government Palace, the Cathedral, the Archbishop's Palace, and the charming bronze fountain. Your “Local Friend” will bring the stories of these places to life, sharing tales of the city's rich history.

While exploring, you'll uncover hidden gems like the Desamparados Train Station and the storied Cordano Bar, Lima's oldest watering hole. Another highlight is the breathtaking San Francisco Church, known for its intricate design and cultural significance.

As the evening deepens, you'll arrive at the world-famous Magic Water Circuit in Parque de la Reserva (*Admission: S/.4 soles pp*). Stroll among 13 illuminated fountains and witness the dazzling water and light show at 7:15 PM—a mesmerizing spectacle that will leave you in awe.



Finally, your guide and driver will ensure a smooth ride back to your hotel, leaving you with unforgettable memories of Lima's magic under the stars.
